For poetry: 8-10 poems

Upload a statement, approximately 300 words in length, that gives us a sense of who you are as a writer and a person.

Two Letters of Recommendation*

Letters should come from educators and mentors who are familiar with you and your work and can speak to your potential as a writer, a member of the MFA cohort, and a teaching assistant.

Recommenders should submit letters in single pdf, labeled with your name (last name first) followed by "LoR" to cwmfaapp@uark.edu by midnight on 12/31/24.
