ENGL 3083, Professional Topics: Crafting a Creative Livelihood for Beginning Writers

Description: This course introduces and demystifies the professional world of creative writing for beginners, as well as for those who may have some experience. Participants will conduct preliminary research on inspiring publication opportunities and post-graduation prospects that fit both their aesthetic tastes and personal ambitions. We will also address how to find (or create) an active literary community after graduation, including applying to residencies, workshops, and grad programs in creative writing.
