Follow in the footsteps of some of the greatest playwrights, writers and artists of all time, and immerse yourself in the world of theatre and culture in London. This study tour of London is open to all majors from all colleges; no theatre experience is required. It includes one week of classroom instruction on campus and four weeks in London with excursions to destinations such as Stratford-up-Avon, Oxford and Bath. Students experience a generous sampling of modern as well as classical drama as performed on the English stage. A typical summer features a broad spectrum of theatre from the earliest dramatic forms to the most current in London and Stratford-upon-Avon. Plays at Shakespeare's Globe, the RSC, National Theatre, and in the West End, as well as other performances and cultural events are included. Students are granted ample free time so that they are able to explore the city on their own, as well as plan weekend trips and activities outside of London.
